1. Monitor and engage with ASN Members, federal agencies, and congressional offices and committees on implementation of kidney-care provisions in MIPPA.
2. Contribute actively on kidney care and patient reforms in any health care reform legislation.
3. Participate in the Kidney Care Partners (KCP) Kidney Care Quality Initiative.
4. Continue to provide thoughtful analysis and policy recommendations on the Patient-Centered Medical Home proposal.
5. Monitor the development of transplantation and immunosuppressive drug coverage legislation.
6. Enhance ASN's World Kidney Day (WKD) efforts and develop a specific legislative ask for WKD.
