

ASN Geriatric Nephrology Program for Medical Students and Residents

The American Society of Nephrology is now accepting applications for the ASN Geriatric Nephrology Program for Medical Students and Residents, a program at ASN Kidney Week 2015, in San Diego, California. Successful applicants will participate in the following activities:

1. Attend the 2015 Geriatric Nephrology Early Program, Wednesday, November 4.
2. Attend a mentoring lunch with faculty during the Early Program.
3. Participate in the ASN [Kidney STARS program](#) during the Annual Meeting.

Awardees will receive a \$1,200 travel stipend and complimentary registration for the Early Program in Geriatric Nephrology and for the ASN Annual Meeting. Five stipends will be awarded.

Eligibility: In order to be eligible for this program, students and residents must be enrolled in an ACGME-accredited program.

Application process: Applications for the Geriatric Nephrology Program should be submitted to ASN no later than July 24, 2015. Applicants should submit a Curriculum Vitae, a statement of their interest in the program (250 words max), and a letter of support from their Medical School Dean or Residency Program Director.
