Don't

- Change the color

Logo Variants

When the logo is used on a colored background, depending on the color, you should reverse the type to white for legibility.

Logo Usage Common Mistakes

Here's how to avoid making a logo mistake:

- 1. Don't scale logo disproportionately.
- 2. Don't use the logo on a conflicting color.

 The background color should not hinder the logo's legibility. Overall, it should be light enough or dark enough to sustain legibility of the logotype.
- 3. Don't place logo on a busy image.
- 4. Don't change colors to the logo file.
- 5. Don't infringe on the clear space.

- 6. Don't add a drop shadow or other filter.
- **7. Don't use a low-resolution logo.** A vector or EPS logo is preferred for high-res printing purposes.
- 8. Don't use the black and white logo when you have the opportunity to use color.


